Dear Faculty, Staff, Parents, and Students,

At the end of February our region suffered one of the most severe winter storms in decades. Some of you received a few feet of snow and many others were without power for days on end. It has been a challenging season.

As of this date, the middle schools and the high school were closed due to inclement weather for 6 days; the elementary schools were closed for 7 days. Having surpassed our allowable 5 snow days, the middle schools and the high school will need to make up one day, and the elementary schools two days.

Barring the use of any additional snow days, the make-up days will follow the schedule as detailed on the 2009-10 School District calendar (revised on November 10, 2009):

1st Make-Up Day (All Schools) – June 25

June 25 is now the official last day for all schools; however, this will be designated as a Superintendent's Conference Day. **Students will not attend.**

2nd Make-Up Day (Elementary Schools Only) – March 29

In accordance with our scheduled make-up days, Arlington elementary schools will be open on Monday, March 29. All elementary students, faculty, and staff should be in attendance on March 29.

If further snow/emergency days are required, additional make up days will be as follows:

- Middle and High School Students: March 29, March 30, March 31
- Elementary School Students: March 30, March 31, April 1

We recognize that this change may be inconvenient, but we look forward to spring and to continued productivity in our schools.
