Eligibility is open to any student currently graduating from Arlington High School who is pursuing full-time studies at an accredited college or university, leading to a career in the visual arts. This \$200 scholarship is funded annually through our Arlington Faculty and Staff “Tiny Canvas” Art Show/Raffle as well as fundraising by our Arlington Art teachers.

Application Details:

Students interested in applying for the ***Arlington Visual Art Scholarship*** must submit:

- A completed application, including a 250-word essay (Font: 12pt Times New Roman) describing how art has influenced your life and your future plans in the visual arts, along with 5–7 images that showcase your artistic work.

*1 physical application copy submitted to your guidance office and
1 digital copy attached to the first slide of your Google Slide portfolio**

- *Google-slide portfolio: Slide 1: Digital form of the application
Slide 2: 250-word essay describing how art has influenced your life and your future plans in the visual arts
(Font: 12pt. Times New Roman)
Slide 3-9: 5–7 images that showcase your artistic work
