



THINGS STUDENTS SHOULD KNOW FOR PSAT TESTING DAY



All Students taking the PSAT on October 11th MUST be registered

- There will be no late registrations
- There will be no same day registrations

Testing Ticket

- Registered students will have a testing ticket that has specific codes for accessing the online PSAT.



Student MUST have charged chrome books & IDs

- You must have a fully charged chrome book
- Chromebook should be able to have 3 hours of work time
- All Students MUST have the student ID displayed on a lanyard around the neck



All students will be assigned to a testing room

- Students who arrive after the proctor has begun to read the testing script will not be admitted and will need to test at another time.
- All students must remain in the testing room for the entire testing time. All students will be dismissed by the proctor at the end of testing.
- No student will be able to leave if they "finish early"



Structure of the Day

- Arlington will be on a 1/2 day schedule
- Grads 9, 10 and 12 will be dismissed at 10:01am
- 11th graders taking the PSAT are to report to cafeteria C/D (11th graders who did not register for the PSAT will also be dismissed at 10:01am)
- 11th grade students will have 1.5 hours between dismissal and testing for lunch.
- 11th grade students may NOT leave the building at anytime including going for lunch



Prohibited Items - CollegeBoard Rules

- Students may NOT wear baseball caps or any other headgear with brims
- Students may NOT have hoods on their head. Hoodies may be worn but the hood MUST remain off.
- Students can only have clear water bottles with no label. All other containers are prohibited.
- Electronic devices
 - Student bags and cell phones will be left in the cafeteria monitored by school safety.
 - Cell phones will be collected in envelopes as is done for Regents exams
- Students may NOT eat in the testing room.
