Coursework: Students will understand how to...

- Utilize context clues to define words in sentences/paragraphs.
- Use vocabulary to increase knowledge of topic.
- > Apply pre-reading strategies to increase comprehension.
- Use strategies such as graphic organizers, charts and maps as comprehension tools.
- Evaluate prior knowledge before reading.
- Analyze individual learning styles and effective multisensory strategies.
- Recognize word clues to increase comprehension.
- Differentiate between fact and opinion.
- > Draw conclusions; make inferences; and create generalizations.
- ➤ Identify main idea, supporting details.
- > Use and identify literary devices.
- Utilize active reading strategies to increase comprehension.
- ➤ Increase critical reading skills to improve comprehension.
- > Determine writer's style and technique.
- ➤ Identify authors' moves in writing.
- Read in specific content area for comprehension.
- Analyze for literal and inferential information.
- > Organize material to improve retention and comprehension.
