Dear Parents/Guardians:

We are excited to announce that we are now offering the convenience of online registration/sports clearance through FamilyID (www.familyid.com).

FamilyID is a secure registration platform that provides you with an easy, user-friendly way to register for our Interscholastic Athletic Teams, and receive sports medical clearance. Family ID also helps us to be more administratively efficient and environmentally responsible. When you register through FamilyID, the system keeps track of your information in your FamilyID profile. You enter your information only once for each family member for multiple uses and multiple programs. **USING ONLINE FAMILY ID WILL BE THE ONLY METHOD OF SPORTS CLEARANCE FROM NOW ON.**

INFORMATION NEEDED TO REGISTER:

It will be helpful to have the following information handy to allow for accurate completion of your online registration.

- Physician and Health Insurance Information
- Medical History including injuries, illnesses, allergies, and medications.

REGISTRATION PROCESS:

A parent/guardian should register by clicking on this link: http://www.familyid.com/arlington-central-school-district-athletics

If you do not have access to a computer please contact the athletic office and one will be made available. NOTE: signing up via cell phone is cumbersome!

Follow these steps:

- 1. To find your program, click on the link provided by the Organization above and select the registration form under the word *Programs*.
- 2. Next click on the green *Register Now* button and scroll, if necessary, to the *Create Account/Log In* green buttons. If this is your first time using FamilyID, click *Create Account*. Click *Log In*, if you already have a FamilyID account.
- 3. *Create* your secure FamilyID account by entering the account owner First and Last names (parent/guardian), E-mail address and password. Select *I Agree* to the FamilyID Terms of Service. Click *Create Account*.
- 4. You will receive an email with a link to activate your new account. (If you don't see the email, check your E-mail filters (spam, junk, etc.).
- 5. Click on the link in your activation E-mail, which will log you in to FamilyID.com
- 6. Once in the registration form, complete the information requested. All fields with a red* are required to have an answer.
- 7. Click the *Save & Continue* button when your form is complete.
- 8. Review your registration summary.
- 9. Click the green *Submit* button. After selecting 'Submit', the registration will be complete. You will receive a completion email from FamilyID confirming your registration.
