A Message from Nurse Carrigan

Thank-you for continuing to be mindful about your student's illnesses and symptoms. Please continue to NOT send students to school sick!

District Policies:

- * Students MUST be 24 hrs free from fever, vomiting, and/or diarrhea WITHOUT medication before returning to school
- * If your student tests positive for **Flu or COVID**, they must be fever free for 24 hours without medication and symptoms must be resolved and/or significantly improved.
- * If your student has tested positive for **Strep**, they must be on antibiotics for a FULL 24 hours before returning to school.

Please note that the Health Office does NOT act as an Urgent Care.

Therefore, you should not send a symptomatic student to school to be assessed by the nurse.

Absence Notifications from School

If you have sent me an email regarding your students absence and then receive an absence notification from the school via phone call, text, email etc. you do NOT need to send me a second email or note. These notifications are automated for all students absent that day.

If you received one of these notifications and have not already notified the school with a reason for the absence, then you must send in a note on return to school or email myself.

Absent Notes/Emails include your students full name, teacher, dates of absence, and reason for absence.
