- A note, as required by NYS Law, must be presented to the Greeter if a student is late. If returning from an absence, a note must be presented to the Main Office or emailed to <u>asmattendance@acsdny.org.</u>
- If your child is to be picked-up, we <u>MUST</u> have a note indicating the date and the full name of the individual who will be signing them out. <u>PHOTO ID</u> will be required to pick-up all students.
