It is meant for us to use as a tool to keep informed about successes and difficulties going on both at school and home.

In the beginning of the year I will also send home a questionnaire for you to fill out to help me "get to know" your child. This is extremely important for us to help learn more about your child and connect with things that he/she is familiar with. This will also help us to determine your child's preferences for reinforcement.

I have also attached a supply list which outlines necessary items to support your child's learning. Due to the unique nature of the class some of the items may seem unconventional. Please make sure to send a healthy snack and a drink for your child every day.
