Just Open A Book

Before Reading

 Look at the cover & point to the title & author.

During Reading

- Explain unfamiliar vocabulary. Incorporate new words throughout the day.
- Read rhyming stories.
 Ask your child to guess the next rhyming word.

After Reading

- Ask the 5 "W's" who, what, where, when & why.
- Ask your child to tell how the story relates to a personal experience e.g. Have you ever? What would you do if?
- Have your child retell the story.
- Ask your child to create a new ending.
