VFE is Spreading Kindness

Recently, our Vail Farm Teaching Assistants took on a very important task. They were charged with planning and facilitating our November school meeting! Our teaching assistants chose to focus on the themes of kindness and acceptance for this month as they felt all of our school community could benefit from finding ways to spread a little goodwill and understanding as they go about their days here at Vail Farm. In order to emphasize our students understanding of kindness and acceptance, our Teaching Assistants shared a video of a reading of the book "It's OK to be Different" by Todd Parr, and then challenged our students to identify ways they can show kindness and acceptance in their own lives.

In addition to our large school meetings, there are several other ways our students can exemplify and be recognized for their kindness, empathy, and responsibility. We have the Vail Farm CARES club available for 3rd, 4th, and 5th graders in which students show appreciation of all the different groups at our school such as the main office, custodial staff, teachers, teacher assistants, support service personnel, and many more. They then put those ideas into action to spread kindness and gratitude throughout our school. Students can also be nominated by staff and fellow students for "Being the One", and they are recognized during our morning announcements as well as photographed with our "Falcon Wings".

Our staff has also taken on the act of recognizing each other for their own positive contributions to our community. Each month we recognize a new staff member as the Falcon Award Winner, who has been nominated by faculty and staff because they exhibit characteristics of "The One". This means they showed kindness, compassion, respect, honesty, acceptance, patience and/or leadership. The awarded stuffed falcon then stays in that person's learning space or working environment until the next assembly when a new staff member will be chosen to receive the award. This practice has helped create a sense of appreciation and compassion within our community. While talking with your child about the school day, don't forget to ask them about ways they have seen kindness exemplified here at school.
