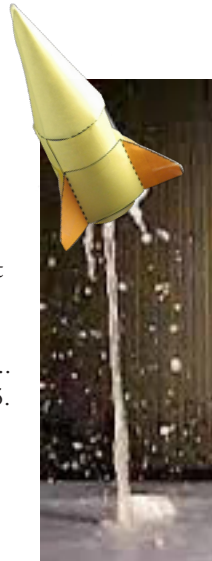

Galaxy Cake Pops

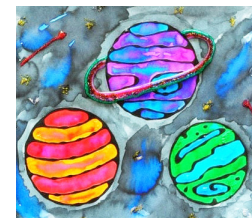

Use Scratch to create a basic animation - control a character on the screen. Ages 8-16.

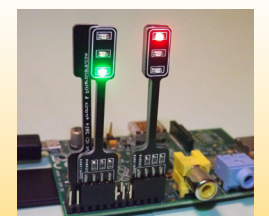
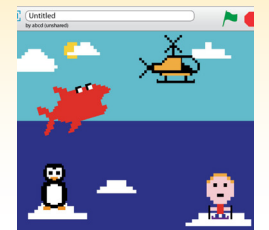
July 17: Program a Traffic Light
