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## Grade 3 - 8 ELA and Math Tests

Our 3<sup>rd</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> grade students will be taking the New York State Exams during April and May.

**ELA exam: April 2 and April 3      Make-ups will be held April 4 - 9**

**Math exam: May 1 and May 2      Make-ups will be held May 3, 6 - 8**

Testing will occur for the entire building from 9:15 to 11:30. Please be sure to be on time to begin exams with your class. Please encourage your child to not worry about test results. The results are to help teachers plan for your child's future instruction. It would help them to get a good night's sleep and eat a healthy breakfast, which we hope students get each day! These tests may have some difficult questions and the results will not impact their grades. All we ask is for the children to try their best.
