News from the Health Office

Several children in our school recently developed gastrointestinal (GI) illness. Symptoms include nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal pain, low grade fever, dehydration and headaches. The illness usually lasts 24 – 72 hours. The best way to **prevent the spread of any GI illness is through proper hand washing.** All children are **not** to return to school for at least **72** hours after diarrhea/vomiting stops. Please call the Health Office with any questions - 845-635-4306. As cold and flu season winds down – a reminder that children should be fever-free for 24 hours before returning to school. Also, all medication **including cough drops** must be kept in the Health Office. Students **cannot** carry or self-administer any over the counter cold medicines of any kind. An excuse note must be provided as well, stating why your child was absent.
