If you would like your student to carry sunscreen with them to self- apply during the day please contact the health office as New York State requires a Permission Form to be completed by the parent allowing your student to carry and apply the sunscreen.

Technology Updates

A reminder that students in grades 2-11 will be keeping their Chromebooks over the summer. Please inspect your child's Chromebook for damage and report any issues via the Parent Technology Help Desk via techhelp@acsdny.org by Friday, June 23. The Technology Department will then reach out to schedule a time for you or your child to drop off the Chromebook to get it repaired during the summer. This will help to prevent a backlog when the school year begins in September.

Students are strongly encouraged to routinely charge their Chromebook throughout the summer to prevent the battery from degrading.

Lost and Found

Please have your child check the lost and found. We are overflowing with sweatshirts, shirts and water bottles on our lost and found table. We also have several pairs of glasses and some jewelry items in the main office. Items will be donated at the end of the school year.





<u>Cell phones</u> are <u>not</u> to be used during the school day. They should be **turned off and** stored in book bags during the day. This also includes watches which have texting ability. Please remind your students that if they have these items they need to be turned off and in their backpacks while on the bus and in school.

<u>Chrome books</u> should be brought to school fully charged each day. Please also remind students that *stickers of any kind* do not belong on Chromebooks. It makes it difficult to redistribute them after being repaired.

<u>Kiss and Go</u> pick up in the afternoon begins at 3:15. It is important that students are picked up on time as we do not always have supervision after 3:30.

Please remember, the circular driveway in front of the school is <u>CLOSED</u> to car traffic during the hours of **8:15 a.m - 9:00 a.m <u>AND</u> 2:30 p.m - 3:30 p.m**. This is for the safety of students and staff during our school day as we prepare for arrival and dismissal

Transportation Reminder

In order to arrange bus transportation to or from a childcare provider, you must complete a Childcare Transportation Request Form (available on the website). This form must be received by **April 1** for transportation to a commercial daycare center outside of our attendance zone, and by **August 15** for an in-home childcare provider. We will only provide transportation to in-home childcare providers that reside within your schools' attendance zone. The form **must be completed** in order for your child to be transported to or from a location other than your home address.
