- Building tours, hosted by our P.T.A., will be held on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>August 21st and Monday</u>, <u>August 26th</u> <u>from the hours of 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m</u>. You might have the opportunity to meet some of the teaching staff during your tour, **if** they are in the building, but many of them are not scheduled to be here these dates.
- On the first few mornings of school, the fourth and fifth grade students are dismissed from the buses first. The third grade students will then be dismissed from the buses directly to their teachers who will be waiting outside. The third grade teachers will escort their students to their classrooms, so they will not need to find their classrooms on their own.
- We will be continuing our "Kiss and Go" dismissal procedure. See more information on "Kiss and Go" on the website.
- Our 6-day rotation for specials will be continuing this school year and will be posted daily on the website.

- Students cannot be dropped off before **8:30 AM**. The side door, facing the parking lot will be locked until that time. No students will be allowed into the building before that time since we do not have any supervision before this time.
- Just a reminder, if your child needs bus transportation to a childcare provider for the 2019 2020 school year, you must complete a Childcare Transportation Request Form which is available on the district website: www.arlingtonschools.org. <u>A new form needs to be completed each year</u> and are due by <u>AUGUST 15th.</u>
