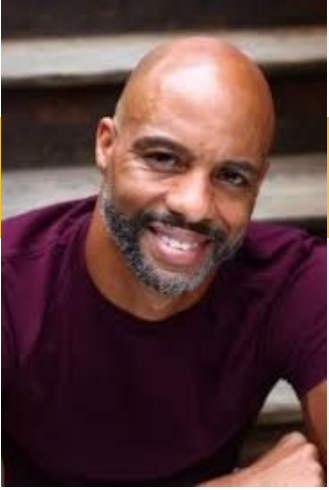

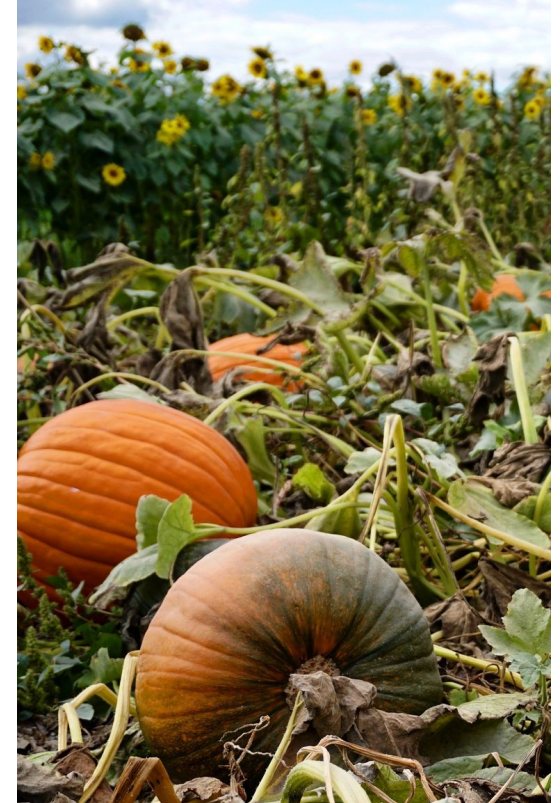

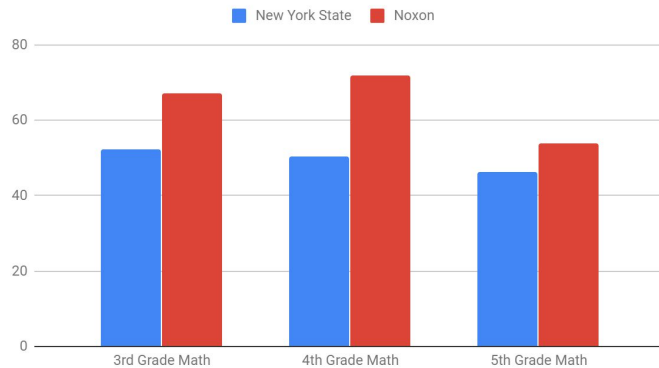
# Professional Learning Communities & State Exams

Math Comparison



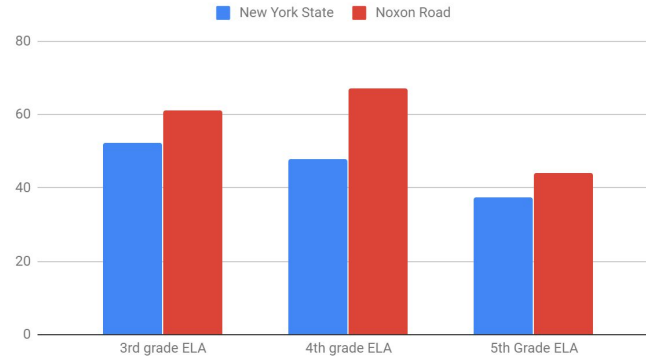

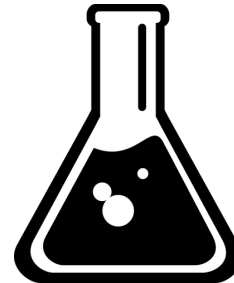
