ARRIVAL EXPECTATIONS

- Arrive to school on time
- Enter the building in an orderly fashion
- Turn off all electronics and make sure they are put away secure fashion
- Unpack quickly and bring all materials to class with you
- Be on time to your first period class
- Come to school dressed appropriately
- Enter the building at the entrance near where your bus parks, using an appropriate voice and language

DISMISSAL EXPECTATIONS

- Report directly to your buses or the pick up circle in an orderly fashion
- Remember all necessary materials to be able to complete all your homework and study
- Be on time for all afterschool activities
- Notify parents/guardians that you are staying for an afterschool activity
- Use appropriate language
- Respect personal space of others
- Exit the building quickly and in an orderly fashion
- Keep hands & feet to yourself
- Be aware of surroundings as you are walking to the bus or your parent's car

BOLTS BATHROOM EXPECTATIONS

 Ask for permission to use the bathroom Use bathroom closest to your classroom Respect others' personal space
 Keep bathrooms clean Flush toilet Seek assistance if fixtures (sinks,toilets,etc.) are broken in the bathroom

HALLWAY EXPECTATIONS


 Walk to the right Walk directly to your next class Use lockers during arrival, before or after lunch, and at dismissal

CAFETERIA EXPECTATIONS

- Find a seat when you enter the cafeteria
- Sign into the lunch table/seat each day
- Clean your eating area
- Speak in a low voice
- Follow the directions of supervising staff
- Wait to be called to the lunch line
- Please have your PIN number ready to show in the lunch line
- Please remask after you finish eating
- Please listen for when recess begins
- Respect others sitting at your table
- Respect other's food choices
- Wait your turn and respect the lunch line
- Walk and move carefully
- Pick up spilled and/or dropped food
- Keep hands and feet to yourself

Recess Walking Track

- Students are permitted to use shareable resources such as basketballs, footballs, frisbees, etc.
- Students are not required to wear masks outside
- Students may walk the recess track counterclockwise
- If the weather cooperates, students may use the entire yellow track (including the grass area).
- If the grass area is extra wet / muddy, students will only walk on the pavement. Effectively cutting the track in half and following the blue arrows.
- Students will enter the building in two rows (pink arrows), using both sets of doors. Students are expected to use hand sanitizer upon entering the building.

BUS EXPECTATIONS

- Follow the bus driver's directions
- Use appropriate voice and language

- Arrive to your bus stop on time

- Remain seated during the bus ride
- Keep the bus clean and neat
- Keep hands inside the bus
- If you see something...say something



LOCKERS

- The recommended locker times is at arrival, before or after lunch and the end of the day.
- You are not allowed to share lockers.
- Please do not use adhesives or tapes to decorate the lockers.
- You will not be allowed to leave your belongings in a classroom or carry with you all day.
- If you happen to forget something in your locker it is up to your teacher to issue you a locker pass. Being late to class because you had to stop at your locker is not considered a reason to be late.



STUDY HALL

- Study Hall is for doing your homework, reading or studying. You will not be allowed to socialize in Study Hall.
- If you would like to use the library during study hall you must receive a pass from the library or your study hall teacher.
- If you need to meet with a teacher during your study hall, please ask for a pass from the teacher to give to your study hall teacher.



LIBRARY

- Sign up for Library takes place before Period 1 begins.
- There are a limited number of passes to the Library for each period.
- Remember to be respectful of others while in the library as other students may use the library for doing homework, reading or studying.



CELL PHONE USE

Cell phones, head/earphones, and earbuds are only allowed to be used before and after school hours and must be kept in a locker or bookbag throughout the school day (7:30am - 2:09pm) unless permission is granted by a staff member.

Students using a cell phone, head/earphones, or earbuds without permission during school hours (from 7:30am- 2:09 pm) are subject to the following consequences:

- ☐ 1st violation: Warning by the staff member
- ☐ 2nd Violation: Required to give my cell phone, headphones, or ear buds
 to a staff member until the end of the period and a parent/guardian will be
 contacted
- ☐ 3rd Violation: Held in the main office and may be picked up by student or a parent/guardian at the end of the day. Administration will contact parent or guardian
- ☐ 4th Violation: Held in the main office until arrangements can be made for a parent/guardian to pick up
