Spackenkill High School and the Council On Addiction Prevention and Education (CAPE) of Dutchess County have joined together in an effort to prevent these tragedies that needlessly take the lives of our children.

On the evening of March 28 and March 30, 2023, Arlington High School and CAPE will host the program, "Teen Driving-A Family Affair".

March 30 - Students last name M-Z

This is a MANDATORY program for students who are applying for school parking permits, and parents/guardians who play such a crucial role in their teen's safe driving. If you wish for your child to be able to drive to school, you and your student driver MUST ATTEND. The program is 7:00pm-8:30pm. Please plan to arrive at 6:30pm for registration, so that the program can begin promptly at 7:00 p.m.

Please note that all students <u>must</u> be accompanied by a parent/guardian. No student shall be permitted to enter the program without their parent/guardian. No exceptions. During this program, parents and students will hear four perspectives; legal, medical, insurance and victim; that will serve to inform and illustrate the importance of responsible choices and decision-making when it comes to driving.

Students may attend the program at a school other than their own if there is a scheduling conflict.

Due to the sensitive nature of the information, and the comfort of our guest speakers, we ask that you refrain from bringing children under the age of 12 years old.
