Seal of Civic Readiness

The Seal of Civic Readiness may be a 4+1 pathway to meet New York State diploma requirements. The Seal of Civic Readiness is considered an approved Pathway that will count for either the Global History Regents Exam or the U.S. History Regents Exam for graduation. Students must still take the exams at the end of the courses.

The Seal of Civic Readiness may also serve as a seal of distinction and honor on a NYS High School Diploma.

If a student has already passed their required Regents Exams they may still earn the Seal of Civic Readiness as a seal of distinction. In this case the Seal would be similar to all other marks of distinction and honor on a NYS High School Diploma, signifying to employers and college admissions officers that this student has demonstrated the civic knowledge, skills, mindsets and experiences necessary to become an active, engaged citizen.

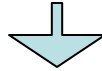

Students can also complete a High School Capstone Project (either individually or as part of the Civic Engagement and Leadership class) to earn additional distinctions within the ACSD Seal of Civic Readiness plan.

Introducing Blended Learning

What is blended learning?

Blended learning courses are a combination of traditional classroom instruction and independent learning. The teacher will determine which days of the week all of the students in the class need to attend during their regularly scheduled period, and which days of the week the students can engage in their learning under their own terms. Traditional classroom instruction will occur at least 3 times per week. The independent learning opportunities will not occur more than 2 times per week.

AHS Career and Technical Education Pathways

Arlington High School has received official New York State Department of Education (NYSED) Career and Technical Education (CTE) Endorsements, and will begin offering 5 CTE pathways during the 2023-2024 school year.

The benefits of CTE Pathways are:

- High Quality:** NYSED approved CTE Pathways are vetted by District administrators, Post-Secondary Institutions and Industry Experts
- Industry Certification:** CTE Pathways lead to certification and/or specialized training in the specific Career Pathway
- Post-Secondary Experiences:** Students will have the opportunity to earn college credit or have other post-secondary experiences
- Graduation Requirements:** AHS Students can graduate with CTE Endorsement and be exempt from one of the five required Regents exams.
- Real World Experiences:** CTE Students will participate in Work Based Learning Experiences to apply what they are learning in the classroom in the Industry.

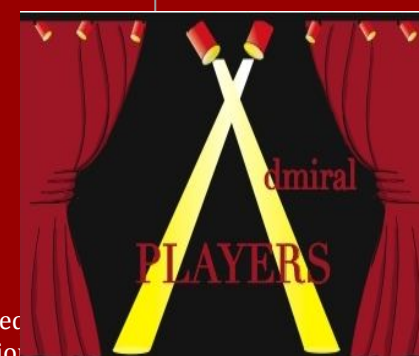

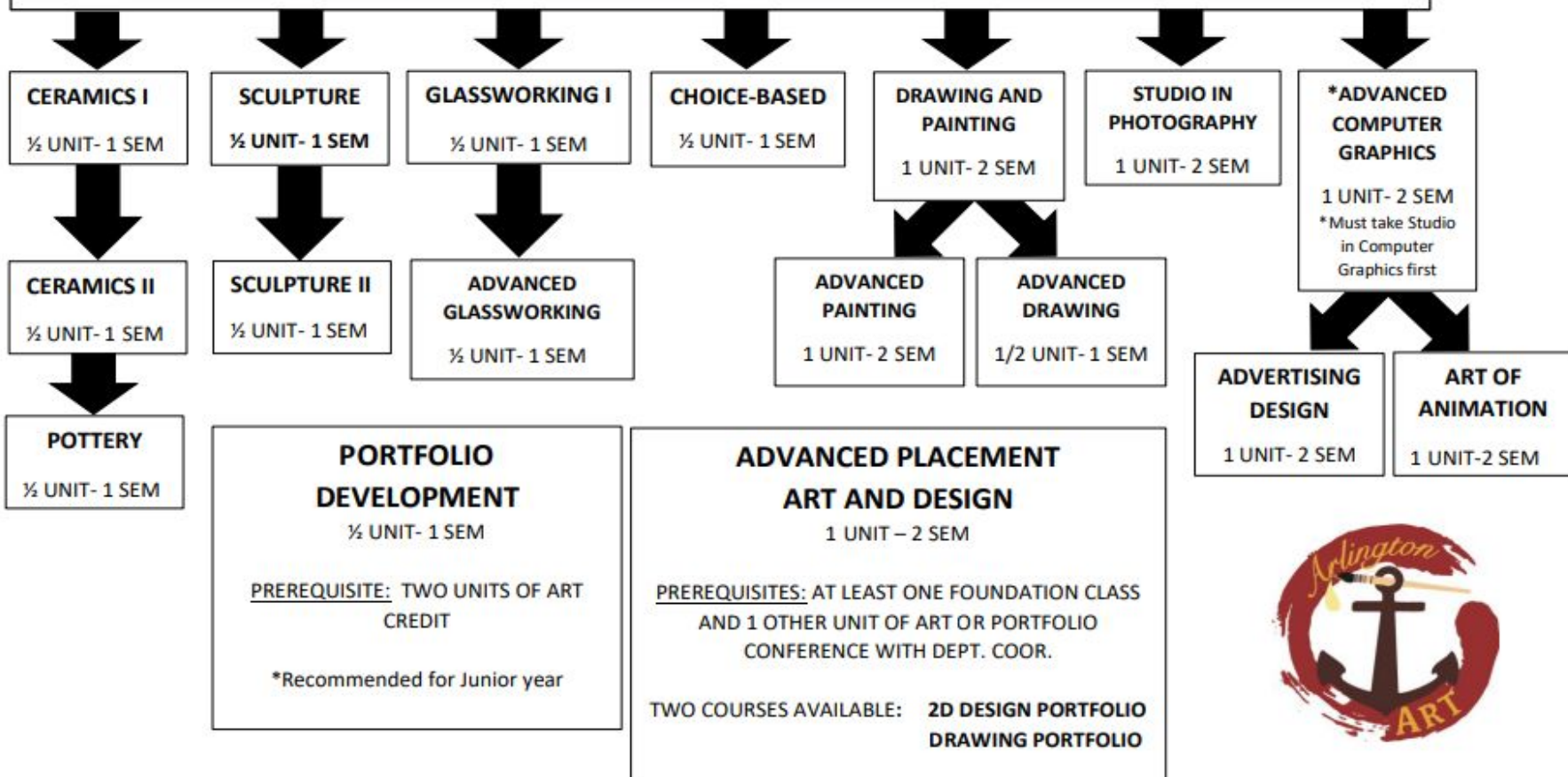
