The January NYS Regents Exams were scheduled to be held between January 25th and 28th. On December 21, 2021, the New York State Education Department announced the cancellation of the January NYS Regents Exams. The above schedule is designed to bring to school students who would not normally have attended school during this week, while still allowing time to administer final exams to our students in semester courses. January 25th and 26th will follow a modified delay schedule for students who are not taking final exams. January 27th is a make-up day for final exams, and will also follow a modified delay schedule. Students who are taking final exams will report to school at their normal time, and take their finals from 8:00-10:00 before continuing on with the rest of the modified schedule. January 28th will be an asynchronous day for students, as well as a make-up exam day.

The buses will run at their normal times for students who need to come to school to take a final exam, and then they will run 2 and a half hours later to bring in the rest of our students. Students who do not have a final exam will be picked up 2 and a half hours later than normal. We recommend students arrive at their bus stop 10 minutes early to ensure pickup.

Exam Reminders:

- Students will be able to enter the building through the MAIN LOBBY and GYM LOBBY 3 ONLY.
- CELL PHONES ARE NOT PERMITTED ON SITE! If a student is seen with a cell phone in the exam room they will not be able to take the exam.
- Personal belongings such as backpacks and bags will not be permitted into the exam area.
- While we do not encourage opting out of any student testing accommodations, your child does have the right to opt out of using their accommodations. Please contact your counselor by January 17 if your child is opting out of any testing accommodations.
- Students should be prepared with pens, pencils, and calculators if necessary. Please, no gel pens.
