## **Guidelines:**

- A. Front of Card must include:
  - 1. Person's picture
  - 2. Person's name
  - 3. Dates of person's life
  - 4. What type of reformer they were (don't just say "social"—be specific)
- B. Back of Card must include (but is not limited to):
  - 1. Five (5) key facts about the person's life-residence, education, family, occupation, etc.
  - 2. Five (5) key facts about the person's **important role in American History**.
  - 3. Batting Average- use the key below to assign a batting average depicting your judgment of this person's impact on American Society. You must include *at least one sentence* explaining the reason for this average.
- C. Baseball Card **must be completed** on a computer.
- D. Proper spelling, punctuation and grammar must be used.
- E. Works Cited Page is turned in- citing your sources for pictures and information in MLA format. (Please remember Wikipedia is not a valid source.)
