- Google Consent Form: This grants permission for your child to access Google's educational suite of tools including G-Suite for Education and Google Classroom.

Before the school year starts:

- Please ensure your child's Chromebook is fully charged and turned on before the first day of school. Chromebooks are set to update automatically, and if they fall behind, the device will prompt students to initiate an update. An outdated Chromebook may prevent students from using it until the update is complete.
- If your child's Chromebook experiences any issues, please email <u>techhelp@acsdny.org</u> to submit a technology help desk ticket. When submitting a request, please include the student's ID number and the building they are assigned to. This information will help our technology team expedite a response.
- Students are encouraged to use their @ACSDNY.ORG email account when submitting a request to our help desk.
- Students in grades 2-12 receive a Chromebook to take back and forth to school. If you are new to the District, your child will receive a Chromebook from the school.
