7) Superintendent/ Board President Report

The District Clerk reported the upcoming events for March, 2014.

Dr. Lyons recognized 9 teachers who received National Board Certification. Dr. Lyons read the National Mission and honored the teachers for their hard work and dedication. This certification is measured against high standards. The teachers spoke about the intensity of the program and how extremely difficult it is. Mr. Benante presented each teacher with the Arlington Certificate of Recognition.

Mrs. Barbara Donegan, Interim Assistant Superintendent of Pupil Personnel, gave a budget presentation. She presented highlights, professional and technical services, and reviewed the projected 1.7 million for 2014-2015. She gave a brief overview of the budget areas which include equipment, materials, supplies, conferences, mileage, and postage. She also reviewed the tuition for CSE placement.

Mr. Benante, Deputy Superintendent, reviewed the budget for health services, guidance services, school psychologist services, school social worker services, speech therapist services, and home teaching.

Mr. George Beckwith, Director of Transportation, gave an overview of the proposed transportation budget. He reviewed interesting facts, fleet overview of a total of 242 buses, staffing, shared transportation, and opportunities for savings. He also spoke about the decline in enrollment and how this affects the transportation fleet size. The presentation also included the proposed bus proposition for 2014-2015, bus proposition history, bus projections 2013-2027, and the financial implications.

Ms. Zimmerman, Assistant Superintendent for Business and Mr. Crisci, Director of Facilities and Operations, reported on the Safety Referendum. They reviewed the history and "how we got to where we are today." They also reviewed the security upgrades district-wide, potential scope modifications, and budget integrations.

For personal reasons it was necessary for Mr. Martin, Board President, to leave the meeting at 8:35 pm. Mr. Rossi assumed leadership and direction of the meeting.

WHEREAS, due to steadily decreasing enrollment in the Arlington Central School District, Superintendent Dr. Brendan Lyons and other District personnel prepared a study and presented it to the Board of Education entitled, "Enrollment and School Closing Report to the Arlington Central School District's Board of Education, November 12, 2013," which recommended closing the Arlington Middle School as a middle school and moving the students to the District's two remaining middle schools, closing the Arthur S. May Elementary School building and moving its students and staff to the Arlington Middle School building; and

WHEREAS, on Tuesday, January 7, 2014, the Board held a public hearing to discuss the closings and redistricting and to solicit and hear comments and questions from the public about the Enrollment and School Closing Report and Recommendations; and

WHEREAS, on January 28, 2014 the Board declared itself Lead Agency for SEQRA review and declared these activities a Type II action under SEQRA having no significant impact on the environment and not subject to further SEQRA review; and

WHEREAS, on January 28, 2014 the Board voted to approve: the closing of the Arlington Middle School, the accommodation of its middle school students at the District's remaining two middle schools, the closing of the Arthur S. May Elementary School building, and the moving of its students and staff to the Arlington Middle School building; and

WHEREAS, on February 11, 2014 Dr. Lyons and George Beckwith, Director of Transportation, presented a proposed plan for redistricting to accommodate the closing, of the Arlington Middle School, and that plan and detailed street listings were posted and have remained on the District's website, and are appended to this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Superintendent, Phil Benante, has been discussing the redistricting changes with transition teams consisting of middle school staff, administrators, parents, and students; and

WHEREAS, these matters have been publicly discussed and deliberated at numerous meetings and forums over the last several months;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,

- 1. That the Board of Education of the Arlington Central School District accept and approve the recommendations for redistricting presented to the Board by Dr. Brendan Lyons and George Beckwith on February 11, 2014, appended to this resolution, and posted on the District's website, which generally stated include: moving the students in the Arthur S. May Elementary School building to the Arlington Middle School building, moving approximately 510 sixth to eighth grade students from the Arlington Middle School to the LaGrange Middle School, and moving approximately 255 sixth to eighth grade students from the LaGrange Middle School to the Union Vale Middle School, as further detailed in the District's New Middle School Attendance Zone Map and the District's Street Listings for the 2014/2015 School Year (appended hereto); and
- 2. That the Board declare that all these changes take effect beginning with the 2014–2015 school year; and
- 3. That the Board hereby authorize the Superintendent to execute and file with the New York State Education Department all documents required to effectuate these changes.

d) <u>SEQRA resolution for the Floor Replacement at the Noxon Road Elementary</u> School and Joseph D'Aquanni/West Road Intermediate School

The Board of Education approve the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Arlington Central School District ("the Board") is planning a project involving the removal and replacement of existing asbestos containing flooring in the Gymnasium and Cafeteria of the Noxon Road Elementary School, and removal and replacement of existing asbestos containing flooring in the Cafeteria of the Joseph D'Aquanni/West Road Intermediate School ("the Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Arlington Central School District is the involved agency principally responsible for undertaking this project; and

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed the components, phases and aspects of the proposed project; and

WHEREAS, the Board has been advised by its architects, Fuller and D'Angelo P.C., that the proposed project consists of activities designated as a

Type II action under SEQRA, specifically, the "replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction of a structure or facility, in kind, on the same site, including upgrading buildings to meet building or fire codes," (6 NYCRR 617.5 (c)(2); and the "routine activities of educational institutions," (6 NYCRR 617.5 (c)(8); and that none of the activities associated with the Project exceed any of the thresholds of a SEQRA Type I action as listed in 6 NYCRR 617.4; and that these activities will have no significant adverse impact on the environment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

- 1. The Board, as the involved agency principally responsible for undertaking the removal and replacement of the flooring in the gymnasium and cafeteria of the Noxon Road Elementary School, and the flooring in the cafeteria of the Joseph D'Aquanni/West Road Intermediate School, declare itself lead agency in the SEQRA process for this proposed action (the Project); and
- 2. The Board, as lead agency in the SEQRA review of the Project declare that it is a Type II action under 6 NYCRR 617, which will not have a significant impact on the environment and is not subject to further SEQRA review.

- Mrs. Lappan stated that the Legislative Advocacy Committee will be meeting with the public on March 4th at 7:00 pm at Central Administrative Offices to discuss the Common Core and APPR proposed resolution. She requested that the district create an advocacy area on the website. She is planning to bring the resolution to the Board for action at the end of March.
