Motion to adjourn to Executive Session to discuss the employment history of particular individuals and collective bargaining of the CSEA. (The public portion of the meeting will open at approximately 7:00 p.m.)

Motion by Mr. Bodnar, seconded by Mr. Rossi, to return to the regular meeting at 7:00 pm. The motion was carried unanimously.

- 3) <u>Roll Call</u> Board Members present were Mrs. Baxter, Mr. Bodnar, Mrs. Eraca, Mrs. Herr, Mrs. Lappan, Mr. McCormick, Mr. McLeod, Mr. Rossi, and Mr. Shuttleworth. Also present were Dr. Lyons, Mr. Benante, Mrs. Flynn-Brown, Mrs. Muenkel, and Mr. Sheldon.
- 4) <u>*Reading of the</u> By Mrs. Lappan <u><i>District Mission*</u></u>
- 5) <u>Approval of the</u> <u>Agenda</u> Motion by Mrs. Baxter, seconded by Mrs. Herr, to approve the agenda as written. The motion was carried unanimously.

6) Code of Conduct – Public Hearing

The Public Hearing was opened.

No public comment at this time.

The Public Hearing was closed.

- 7) <u>Correspondence</u> Mrs. Eraca stated she has received additional information regarding the naming of the track.
- 8) *Public Comment* There was an audience of approximately 250.

Comments were shared in support of the "School to Work" program.

A parent would like her daughter to be recognized for perfect attendance.

Several members of the community spoke in support of the security greeters.

Several people spoke in support of naming the track after Coach Arnett.

- 9) <u>Board President's</u> Mrs. Lappan reminded everyone that the Board's responsibility is always to look at the larger picture on issues for the benefit of the entire school district.
- 10) <u>Superintendent's</u> <u>Remarks</u> Dr. Lyons acknowledged students in the Video Production class. He congratulated the students and Mr. Sheedy for the honors they recently received. Dr. Lyons congratulated the senior class and reminded everyone that Graduation is Saturday, June 27, at 1:00 pm. Dr. Lyons spoke about the process that the District recently went through with the CSEA. He commented on their professionalism and how well everyone worked together in regards to their negotiations. Dr. Lyons wished everyone a safe and relaxing summer.

11) <u>Reports and Board</u> <u>Discussion Items</u>

Veteran's Tax Exemption Update - Mr. Kevin Sheldon

Mr. Sheldon presented on the Veteran's Tax Exemption. He stated that the presentation given last year was based on estimates. He now has clearer information and spoke about how it would have impacted the tax payers. Mr. Sheldon also stated that the Board of Education asked him to work with the Dutchess County Real Property Tax Service and the Dutchess County Office of Veterans Services. He presented the results of that work, and reviewed the next steps.

Annual Special Education Report – Mr. Chris Bayer

Mr. Bayer presented the Annual Special Education Report. He spoke about the focus of the District and reviewed the academic achievement, social and emotional competency, access to general education environment and curriculum, compliance with regulations, and fiscal responsibility. He reviewed the range of quality programs that are in place and sustaining these programs as well as college and career readiness.

Writing Units of Study – Mrs. Dana Brown

Mrs. Brown presented the Writing Units of Study presentation. She highlighted the purpose of the pilot and the implementation. She showed examples of the students' work and shared some of the teacher survey comments. Mrs. Brown also reviewed the recommendation, the professional development offered to the teachers, curriculum mapping and the projected costs. She also spoke about the measurement of effectiveness.

Lyons as Superintendent of Schools of the Arlington Central School District for the period of time commencing July 1, 2015 and terminating on June 30, 2018, with annual compensation of \$202,000 effective July 1, 2015 and through June 30, 2016; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board hereby authorizes its President to execute an Agreement with Dr. Lyons which sets forth the terms and conditions of his employment as Superintendent of Schools from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2018, a copy of which Agreement shall be incorporated by reference within the minutes of this meeting; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, effective July 1, 2015, the Superintendent's Contract dated March 27, 2012 is hereby declared null and void and of no further effect.

d) <u>Naming of Track</u>

Motion by Mr. Rossi, seconded by Mrs. Baxter, to approve the following resolution. The motion failed 8 to 1. Mrs. Baxter was in favor of the resolution.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education pursuant to Policy #7500, Naming Facilities, hereby authorizes the naming of the track at Arlington High School in honor of Mr. Stephen Arnett, for his service to the students of Arlington High School.

BOND RESOLUTION OF THE ARLINGTON CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT, NEW YORK, ADOPTED JUNE 23, 2015, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF VARIOUS SCHOOL BUSES, VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT FOR USE BY THE DISTRICT, STATING THE ESTIMATED TOTAL COST THEREOF IS \$2,008,500, APPROPRIATING SAID AMOUNT THEREFOR, AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$2,008,500 SERIAL BONDS OF SAID DISTRICT TO FINANCE SAID APPROPRIATION.

Recital

WHEREAS, at the Annual District Meeting and Election duly called and held on May 19, 2015, in the Arlington Central School District, in the County of Dutchess, New York, the qualified voters present and voting approved the Bond Proposition authorizing the Board of Education to purchase various school buses, vehicles and equipment for use by the District, at the estimated total cost of \$2,008,500, and to levy and collect a tax to be collected in annual installments to pay the principal of and interest on the serial bonds authorized to be issued; Now, therefore,

THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE ARLINGTON CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT, IN THE COUNTY OF DUTCHESS, NEW YORK, HEREBY RESOLVES (by the favorable vote of not less than two-thirds of all the members of said Board of Education) AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Arlington Central School District, in the County of Dutchess, New York (herein called "District"), is hereby authorized to purchase various buses, vehicles and equipment for use by the District. The estimated total cost thereof, including preliminary costs and costs incidental thereto and to the financing thereof, is \$2,008,500 and said amount is hereby appropriated therefor. The plan of financing includes the issuance of \$2,008,500 serial bonds of the District to finance said appropriation, and the levy and collection of taxes on all the taxable real property in the District to pay the principal of said bonds and the interest thereon as the same shall become due and payable.

Section 2. Serial bonds of the District in the principal amount of \$2,008,500 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the provisions of the Local Finance Law, constituting Chapter 33-a of the Consolidated Laws of the State of New York (herein called "Law"), to finance said appropriation.

Section 3. The following additional matters are hereby determined and declared:

(a) The period of probable usefulness of the class of objects or purposes for which said serial bonds are authorized to be issued, within the limitations of Section 11.00 a. 89 of the Law, is five (5) years.

(b) The proceeds of the bonds herein authorized, and any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of said bonds, may be applied to reimburse the District for expenditures made after the effective date of this resolution for the purpose or purposes for which said bonds are authorized. The foregoing statement of intent with respect to reimbursement is made in conformity with Treasury Regulation Section 1.150-2 of the United States Treasury Department.

Section 4. Each of the bonds authorized by this resolution, and any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of the sale of said bonds, shall contain the recital of validity as prescribed by Section 52.00 of the Law and said bonds, and any notes issued in anticipation of said bonds, shall be general obligations of the District, payable as to both principal and interest by general tax upon all the taxable real property within the District without limitation of rate or amount. The faith and credit of the District are hereby irrevocably pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and interest on said bonds, and any notes issued in anticipation of said bonds, and provision shall be made

annually in the budget of the District by appropriation for (a) the amortization and redemption of the bonds and any notes in anticipation thereof to mature in such year and (b) the payment of interest to be due and payable in such year.

Section 5. Subject to the provisions of this resolution and of the Law and pursuant to the provisions of Section 21.00 relative to the authorization of the issuance of bonds with substantially level or declining annual debt service, Section 30.00 relative to the authorization of the issuance of bond anticipation notes and Section 50.00 and Sections 56.00 to 60.00 of the Law, the powers and duties of the Board of Education relative to authorizing bond anticipation notes and prescribing the terms, form and contents and as to the sale and issuance of the bonds herein authorized, and of any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of said bonds, and the renewals of said bond anticipation notes, are hereby delegated to the President of the Board of Education, the chief fiscal officer of the District.

Section 6. The validity of the bonds authorized by this resolution, and of any notes issued in anticipation of the sale of said bonds, may be contested only if:

(a) such obligations are authorized for an object or purpose for which the District is not authorized to expend money, or

(b) the provisions of law which should be complied with at the date of the publication of such resolution, or a summary thereof, are not substantially complied with,

and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity is commenced within twenty days after the date of such publication, or

(c) such obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the constitution.

Section 7. This bond resolution shall take effect immediately, and the District Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish the foregoing resolution, in summary, together with a Notice attached in substantially the form prescribed by §81.00 of the Law in the official newspapers of the District.

g) Sale of Raymond Avenue Property

Motion by Mr. Shuttleworth, seconded by Mr. Rossi, to approve the following resolution. The motion was carried unanimously.

WHEREAS, the Arlington Central School District (ACSD) has closed and vacated the former Arthur S. May Elementary School Building at 25 Raymond Avenue, Poughkeepsie, New York, and there is no foreseeable future use for this property for school district purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education, as fiduciaries of the ACSD with the obligation to obtain the highest price for the property in the best interest of the School District, has conducted a sealed bid process for the sale/lease of this property, and has received several offers for the purchase of the property with improvements; and

WHEREAS, upon review of all of the offers, the Board of Education has determined that it is in the best interest of the School District to sell such building and property to Chelnik Real Estate Equities, LLC, the party presenting the highest offer to purchase;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the ACSD declares the property located at 25 Raymond Avenue, Poughkeepsie, New York as surplus and of no further use to the School District, authorizes its sale, and accepts the offer of \$2,401,000.00 from the purchaser Chelnik Real Estate LLC; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board President is authorized to execute a Contract of Sale with Chelnik Real Estate Equities, LLC, upon approval of same by the School Attorney, and that the Assistant Superintendent for Business is authorized to send notification of the acceptance of the offer to Chelnik Real Estate Equities, LLC.

h) <u>Non-unit Salaries</u>

Motion by Mr. McLeod, seconded by Mrs. Eraca, to approve the following resolution. The motion was carried unanimously.

The Board of Education approves salaries for non-unit employees totaling 3,073,131.84. This is a net increase of 51,128.84 from the 2014 - 2015 school year.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board hereby ratifies the provisions of a Memorandum of Agreement executed by the negotiators for the Civil Service Employees Association, Inc. and the District, and authorizes the expenditure of those monies necessary to implement the terms of the July 1, 2015 - June 30, 2019 Collectively Negotiated Agreement.
