8) Board President's Mr. Rossi stated this was the last meeting of the school year. He attended
Remarks the 8th grade recognition nights and said they were wonderful events.
The students looked so proud. He said it makes everything we do worth
it. He announced that the Reorganizational Meeting is scheduled for July
11th at 5:00 pm at the Central Administration Office.

9) **Superintendent's
Remarks**

Dr. Lyons stated graduation was a great day. Mrs. Roberto and her staff did a wonderful job in organizing the graduation. Dr. Lyons stated that it has been a great school year. He received a lot of positive feedback through letters and e-mails. He stated that it reminds us why we are here. He stated the Family Engagement Survey closed on June 23rd. He will be sharing the results later in the summer.

10) **Reports and Board Discussion Items**

Special Education – Dr. Tina DeSa

Dr. DeSa shared history and accomplishments as it relates to Special Education. She reviewed the data broken down by category and total number of students. She also reviewed the three year classification trends and students with disabilities by classification. Dr. DeSa spoke about the different programs that Arlington offers within District and out of District. She spoke about the goal to place students in the least restrictive environment. She reviewed the improvement initiatives that took place at the high school level, middle school level, and elementary school level. She also reviewed local diploma options, commencement credentials, and graduation rates.

K-5 Reading Units of Study – Ms. Dana Brown

Mr. Benante introduced Mrs. Brown, Director of ELA and Social Studies. She presented the K-5 Reading Units of Study Presentation. She explained the purpose of the pilot. The pilot was carried out over the past two years, involving 90 pilot classrooms across the K-5 level. She also reviewed the results of the survey distributed to the teachers. 75% of pilot teachers agreed or strongly agreed that reading has raised the level of student reading in their classroom. Also, 77% of pilot teachers agreed or strongly agreed that the study kit supported their teaching skills. Ms. Brown shared several teacher comments from the survey. She reviewed the recommendations and the projected costs.

Board Member, Jennifer Eraca, left the meeting at 8:10 pm.
