Annual Special Education Report – Vanessa Weeks

Ms. Weeks gave an overview and general picture of Special Education throughout the District. She reviewed the department goals and Special Education Law. Ms. Weeks also reviewed the classification rates and graduation rates. District programs were discussed which include resource room, integrated co-teaching and special class.
