c) Beekman Water Addendum to Memorandum of Understanding

Motion by Mrs. Baxter, seconded by Mr. McLeod, to approve the following resolution. The motion was carried unanimously.

WHEREAS, Dutchess County Water and Wastewater Authority (DCWWA) and the Arlington Central School District (ACSD) are parties to a Memorandum of Understanding dated June 28, 2011 (the "MOU"); and

WHEREAS, the DCWWA and ACSD wish to have the ACSD pay for the bidding for and construction of the pipeline between DCWWA's water distribution point and the ACSD's Beekman Elementary School, but have DCWWA responsible for the work involved in conducting and awarding the bid and for implementing and overseeing the construction of the pipeline; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the MOU, DCWWA procured and is the holder of certain Water Main Distribution Easements and Temporary Water Main Distribution Easements; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the MOU, DCWWA and the SCHOOL DISTRICT entered into a License Agreement dated November 13, 2013, whereby DCWWA granted to the ACSD a license to enter the Easement Areas to construct and install the Interconnection; and

WHEREAS, ACSD will no longer need to enter the easement properties to conduct the work;

BE IT RESOLVED, that the ACSD execute an Addendum to the MOU with DCWWA, substantially in the form as appended to this resolution, establishing that: DCWWA will conduct bidding on and perform the construction of the interconnection crossing the properties for which it holds easements; that DCWWA will also construct the connection to this system from the Beekman Elementary School property line to the schools pump house; and that the ACSD will pay for these activities; and that the License Agreement executed by the ACSD and DCWWA on November 22, 2013 is terminated; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Assistant Superintendent for Business is authorized to execute the Addendum to the MOU, and the Water User Agreement (appended to the MOU Addendum), and any other documents required to carry out the intent of this resolution.

d) APPR Implementation Certification

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education has an established Retirement Contributions Reserve, and hereby authorizes and directs the District Treasurer to increase this reserve in the amount of \$1,829,675 from the 2015-16 surplus.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education has an established Tax Certiorari Reserve, and hereby authorizes and directs the District Treasurer to decrease this reserve in the amount of \$2,029,675 from the 2015-16 surplus.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education has an established Buildings and Facilities Improvement Reserve, and hereby authorizes and directs the District Treasurer to increase this reserve in the amount of \$8,500,000 from the 2015-16 surplus.
