 Dr. Lyons introduced Mr. Jon Handman, Orchestra Director. Mr. Handman stated that the Philharmonia sent in a recording to the New York State School Board Association and was chosen to perform at their upcoming convention. He is very honored and proud to be part of this event. He is thankful for the support the music program receives and he thanked all the individuals that have been involved in helping prepare for this event.

Dr. Lyons introduced Dr. Richard Hooley, the new Dutchess BOCES Superintendent. Dr. Hooley wanted to introduce himself to the board members and audience. He thanked everyone for the opportunity to meet them and stated that he plans on visiting in the future.

Dr. Lyons attended a brunch on October 4th hosted by Dutchess Outreach. The Arlington Central School District received a "Community Partner" award for all its involvement with community organizations. He is very proud of all the hard work the students have contributed to local agencies.
