# ARLINGTON CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT MINUTES OF THE BUSINESS MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION UNION VALE MIDDLE SCHOOL NOVEMBER 4, 2014

President Kelly Lappan called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm at Union Vale Middle School, 1657 E. Noxon, Road, LaGrangeville, NY 12540.

5) Approval of the Agenda

- 7) **Public comment** There was an audience of approximately 40. Mr. Dennis Maloney, resident, shared his thoughts about Common Core and No Child Left Behind.

Mr. Brian Brutting, parent, spoke about his personal concerns regarding fair and equal communication with parents. He asked the Board to consider adopting a policy that would speak to this.

8) **Board President's** Mrs. Lappan has attended ongoing school visits and stated that they have been very good. She also expressed to the Board that if they cannot attend the visits, that they may want to attend the All School Meetings. She encouraged the Board to attend one or more of these meetings. The meetings are always very informative and a great way for Board Members to be informed of what is happening in the buildings.

#### 9) Superintendent Remarks

Dr. Lyons thanked Mr. Wood and the PTA for hosting this evening's meeting. He also thanked the Orchestra and Mrs. Rizzo for their performance.

Dr. Lyons recognized three employees who will be retiring this year, Mary Byrne, Penny Broadie, and Janet Rose. Ms. Byrne and Ms. Broadie have done tremendous work in the Business Office, and Ms. Rose has been a bus driver for the past 30 years with a very clean driving record. He congratulated all three employees for their hard work and dedication to the Arlington Central School District.

Dr. Lyons announced that the sectional football game against John Jay High School will take place on November 8<sup>th</sup> in Mahopac. He also announced that the Admiral Players will be performing in the play, The Three Musketeers, on November 14, 15 and 16 at Arlington High School.

Dr. Lyons expressed his condolences for Peggy Hansen. She was a 4<sup>th</sup> grade Teacher at Noxon Elementary School. He shared words of gratitude for Ms. Hansen's years of service to the District.

In response to Mr. Maloney's comments, Dr. Lyons stated that every district adopted Common Core, and that the learning standards experience has been a very positive one. He has been hearing very good feedback regarding what has been happening in the classrooms. He also stated that this was not a secret. There were many meetings and opportunities to inform parents. In response to Mr. Brutting's comments, Dr. Lyons stated that there is policy and then there is practice. In his research he found that throughout the state it is not common for school districts to have a policy regarding "fair and equal communication."

Mr. Phil Benante talked about Superintendent's Conference Day. The focus was the alignment of District goals with building goals and course goals. At a future date the Principals will report on the progress the teachers are making with the course goals.

# 10) Reports and Board Discussion Items

#### **Union Vale Middle School Transition Report - Mr. Wood**

Mr. Wood welcomed everyone to the meeting and thanked the PTA for providing refreshments. He also thanked the PTA for the new LED sign. The students and Mrs. Rizzo were in attendance to perform for the Board and the audience. Mr. Wood thanked them as well. Mr. Wood's presentation focused on the transition and centered on the three main groups, students, staff and parents. He spoke about the impact on the  $6^{th}$ graders and the post card project. Many events took place, including walkthroughs, team building days, Rachel's Story, and Monster Mash-Up. He thanked the Board and Dr. Lyons several times in regards to the additional new clubs and sports. The transition brought in 13 new full-time employees. On March 28<sup>th</sup>, Professional Development Day, the staff at Union Vale met with the new employees to get to know each other and find out what their needs were. Parents had an opportunity to attend two "Parent Night" events and also Open House. In summary, Mr. Wood stated that the transition went very well and the students have been doing a fantastic job.

Dr. Lyons stated that the Board Members received a budget calendar at their place this evening. This maps out the budget process between now and the Budget Vote.
