2) **Re-establish Tax Certiorari Reserve Fund**

WHEREAS during the fiscal year 2012-13 real property tax certiorari proceedings were commenced by petitioners in which the aggregate real property tax refunds sought from the District by the petitioners in those proceedings exceeds the amount of \$2,447,730 and

WHEREAS all of the above proceedings remain pending and the sum of \$2,435,859 may reasonably be necessary to satisfy judgments that may be rendered in those proceedings;

The amount of \$1,142,765.81 shall be reaffirmed and deposited into the Tax Certiorari Reserve pursuant to Section 3651 (1-a) of the Educational Law and in respect of real property tax certiorari proceedings in connection with the 2008-09 assessment roll and prior.

The amount of \$140,924.00 shall be deposited into the Tax Certiorari Reserve pursuant to Section 3651 (1-a) of the Educational Law in respect of real property tax certiorari proceedings in connection with the 2009-10 assessment roll.

The amount of \$190,619.00 shall be deposited into the Tax Certiorari Reserve pursuant to Section 3651 (1-a) of the Educational Law in respect of real property tax certiorari proceedings in connection with the 2010-11 assessment roll.

The amount of \$761,217.77 shall be deposited into the Tax Certiorari Reserve pursuant to Section 3651 (1-a) of the Educational Law in respect of real property tax certiorari proceedings in connection with the 2011-12 assessment roll.

The amount of \$200,332.50 shall be deposited into the Tax Certiorari Reserve pursuant to Section 3651 (1-a) of the Educational Law in respect of real property tax certiorari proceedings in connection with the 2012-13 assessment roll.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board hereby re-establishes a Tax Certiorari Reserve Fund for the payment of judgments and claims in pending tax certiorari proceeding for the 2013-14 school years and hereby authorizes the transfer of such amount from unassigned fund balance to the tax Certiorari Reserve Fund.

3) **Accept DOT Compensation for Sign at Arlington High School**

**WHEREAS**, the sign at the entrance to the High School must be removed and relocated to accommodate the Department of Transportation (DOT) improvements to the section of Route 55 abutting the entrance to the High School; and

**WHEREAS**, the sign is old and not worth relocating and would be of little or no value to the District if it is removed; and

**WHEREAS**, the DOT commissioned an appraisal of the current value of the sign which valued it at \$6,339.00; and

**WHEREAS**, as a result the DOT has offered to compensate the District in the amount of \$6339.00 for the sign; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education deems it in the best interest of the Arlington Central School District to accept the DOT's offer of compensation for the high school sign;

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:**

That the Board of Education accept the New York State Department of Transportation's offer of \$6339.00 as compensation for the sign at the entrance to Arlington High School on Route 55, and

The Superintendent and the Assistant Superintendent for Business of the Arlington Central School District are empowered to execute the Agreements and any subsequent papers required to secure payment.
