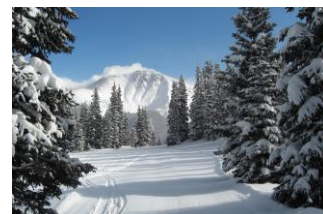
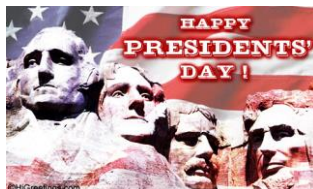


WELCOME TO THE UVMS DAILY BULLETIN!

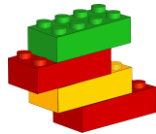
