About Our Classroom- Room 105

Our classroom is in the modular wing. I love to use bright, cheerful colors to make it an inviting learning space. 😊 Each friend will have his/her own desk space. There will also be “quiet workspace” areas around the room.

You will have a special folder (called a R.O.B.O.T. folder) that will travel every day between home and school to help you stay organized. I’ll share more information about this folder once the school year starts.

You will need to bring a healthy snack (fruit, veggie sticks, pretzels, granola bars, yogurt... etc) to school each day. You may also bring a water bottle to drink from during snack (sugary drinks/juices are not permitted for snack time).

We have 5 classroom Chromebook computers! We will be working more and more independently with our classroom computers.

Our schedule will also include a daily “special.” (physical education, library, art, music) Sneakers should be worn on P.E. (gym) days, and are generally best for outdoor play.

Responsibility for your self and your work, respect for your teacher and classmates, and independence (growing your reading and writing stamina) are all expected this year. You are the leaders of the school! Get yourself ready to be an amazing second grader!

School Supplies

 - 1 set of earbuds or headphones (please label)
 - 1 container of unscented baby wipes
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- 1 extra large hand sanitizer pump (*optional, but donations are appreciated!)
