

100 Day Goals

This year, Arlington High School has been challenged to create 100 day goals for our faculty and students. Our priority this year is maximizing our graduation rate, and working to ensure that our students in grades 9-11 remain on track to graduate on time. Additionally, we have renewed our commitment towards our Professional learning communities in order to enhance student learning across the content areas.

Our first goal is to position at least 90% of our students in each grade level to be on track to graduate. Although our 2020-2021 graduation rate was just under 94%, the graduate rate for the last “normal” year of school prior to the pandemic was 88%. Of course we’re working towards 100%, but it may take longer than 100 days to get all of our students who are currently off track back on track to graduate.

Our second goal is to reboot our Professional Learning Communities with our teaching faculty. We hope to spend our next 100 days exploring meaningful areas of interest for our teachers to improve the learning experiences for our students. We will measure this in January with a qualitative analysis during a teacher share fair.
